Horseshoe League Rules and Scoring

Cost

Membership/League Entry Fee	\$20.00
Cost per Week (Including Byes)	\$ 6.00

There will be a weekly 50/50 drawing with proceeds going toward prize money and/or food and beverages for the end of the session party. Secretary Fee is \$10.00 per week.

League Rules

Averages for the first 3 weeks pitched are weighted with a player's established average. After 3 weeks pitched, averages stand on their own. There will be a weekly prize of \$20.00 to the player with the most points over their average in the Second game.

If a player hasn't pitched within the last 12 months, they may choose to re-establish their average and will be considered a New player. New players are ineligible for the weekly prize until a 3-week average is established excluding byes.

Starting Time is Thursday at 6:30 PM.

Any team not present by 6:45 PM forfeits game one.

Any team not present by 7:00 PM forfeits all four games.

There must be one member of a team present to constitute a team.

A team may pitch with a blind. The handicap will be figured using the missing player's average. Game totals for the missing player will be 90% of their current average.

A substitute may be used in place of one team member.

A substitute must come from the substitute list unless the league secretary is notified in advance.

A substitute MUST have an established average. An average may be established by pitching 9 games while another player is present. This includes pitching during a blind as a "silent" partner.

In lieu of forfeits, teams may arrange to postpone their match; however, the postponed match must occur no later than Sunday, and arrangements must be made to get score sheets to the league secretary at the end of the match.

Scoring

A match will consist of pitching (3) 36 shoe games per week.

A fourth game is calculated using total points.

A ringer is 3 points and a shoe within 6" of the peg is 1 point. All points count (no cancellations).

A shoe must land cleanly in the pit and on the fly to count. Any shoe which contacts the border or backboard is dead and is to be removed from the pit.

A Handicap will be calculated using 80% of the difference in the two teams' averages. Any fractions are dropped.

Teams are awarded 2 points in the standings for each game won and 1 point for a tie.

The National Horseshoe Pitcher's Association Rules will apply for any situation not covered by these rules.
